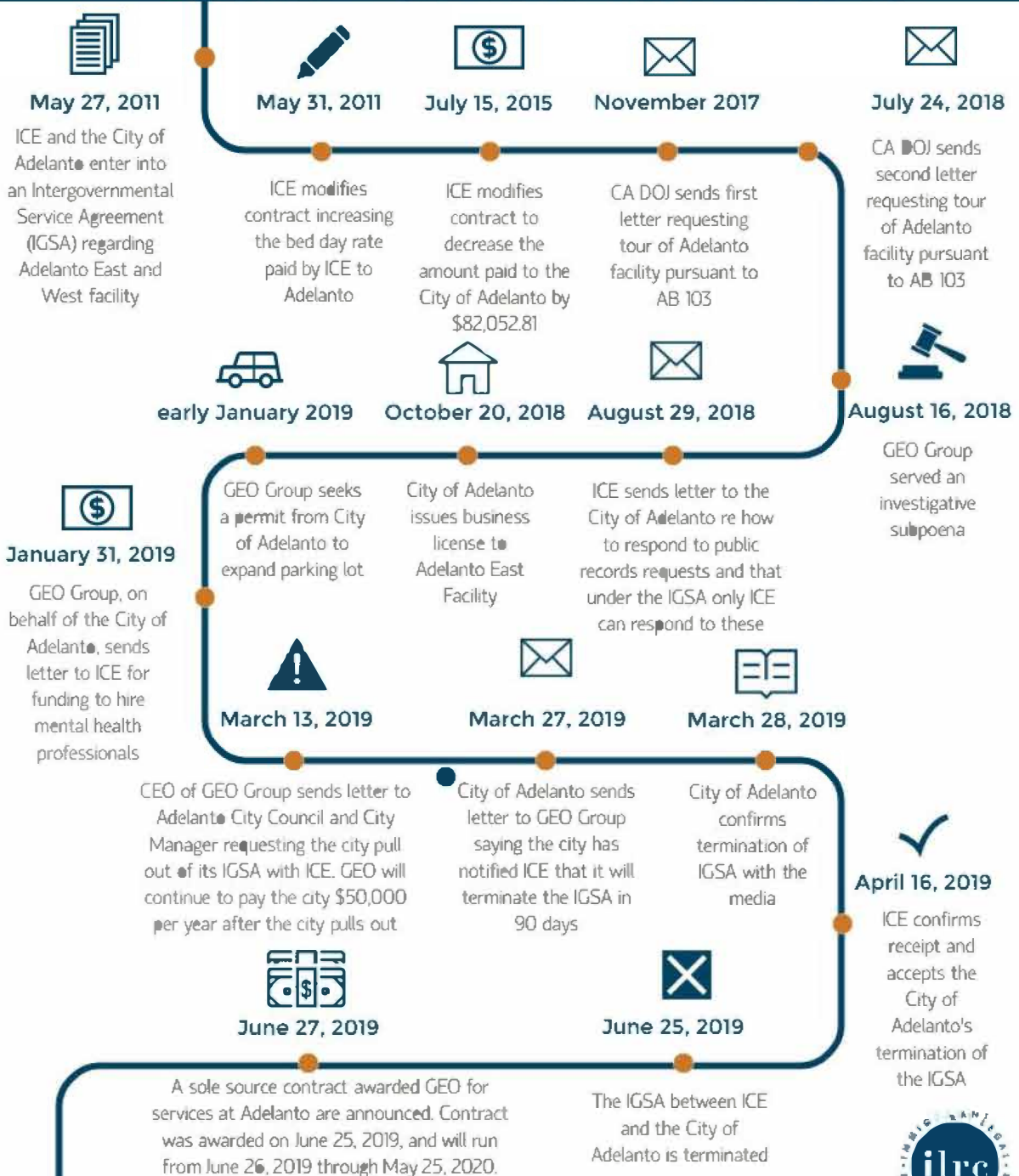


# TIMELINE OF ADELANTO'S IMMIGRATION DETENTION CONTRACT

Overview of ICE's contracts with the City of Adelanto and GEO Group for immigration detention at the Adelanto ICE Processing Center





**December 19, 2019**

GEO contracts with U.S. Government for Adelanto and an additional annexed facility, Desert View. Contract is for three, five-year renewable terms. The first term ends December 19, 2024. The contract generates \$85 million in annualized revenue for GEO.



**January 2020 - September 2020**

- Adelanto city holds permit hearings to convert use of the Desert View state prison into an immigration detention center.
- Four hearings are held before the Adelanto Planning Commission and City Council. Community testimony largely opposes the permit and press covers alleged malfeasance. The permit is ultimately approved.



**April 2020**



**June 2023**

To safeguard the health of people in Adelanto during the COVID-19 pandemic, a federal district court in *Roman v. Wolf* grants an injunction directing no new detained people and a reduction of the population.

HEAL passes in CA, allocating \$5 million from the CA Workforce Development Board to any city or county that withdraws from immigration detention.



**December 19, 2023**

ICE issues a series of task orders considering closure of Adelanto. As of May 2024, three task orders have been issued, set to end September 30, 2024.

### **What's next? Two options**

- 1) Invest in incarceration by keeping Adelanto open, or
- 2) Invest in local communities by phasing out Adelanto and introducing better jobs and healthier economies by leveraging HEAL and other state and federal programs.
